

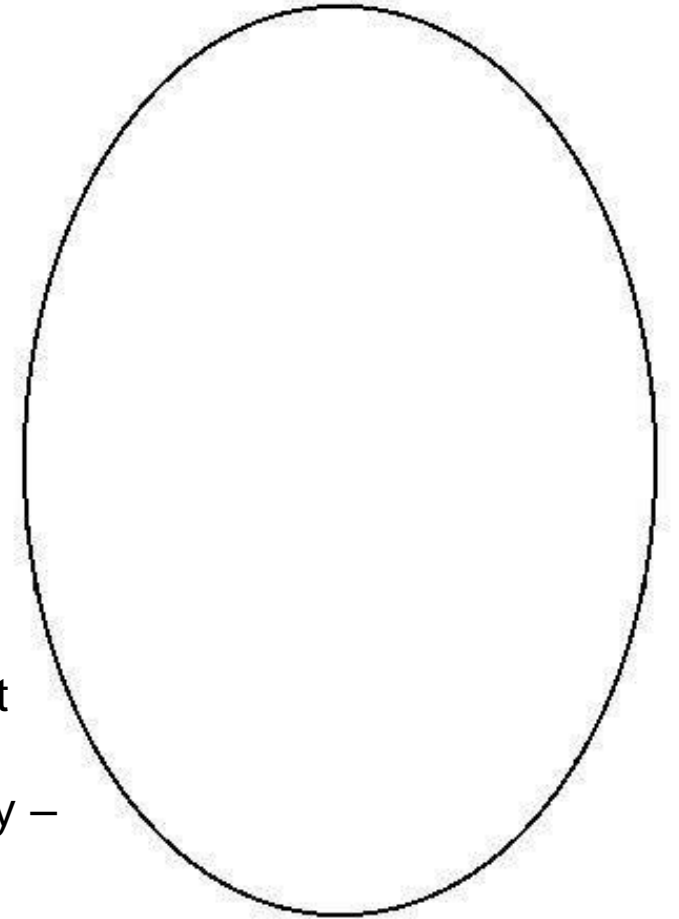
Salt Painting Easter Eggs

What you will need:

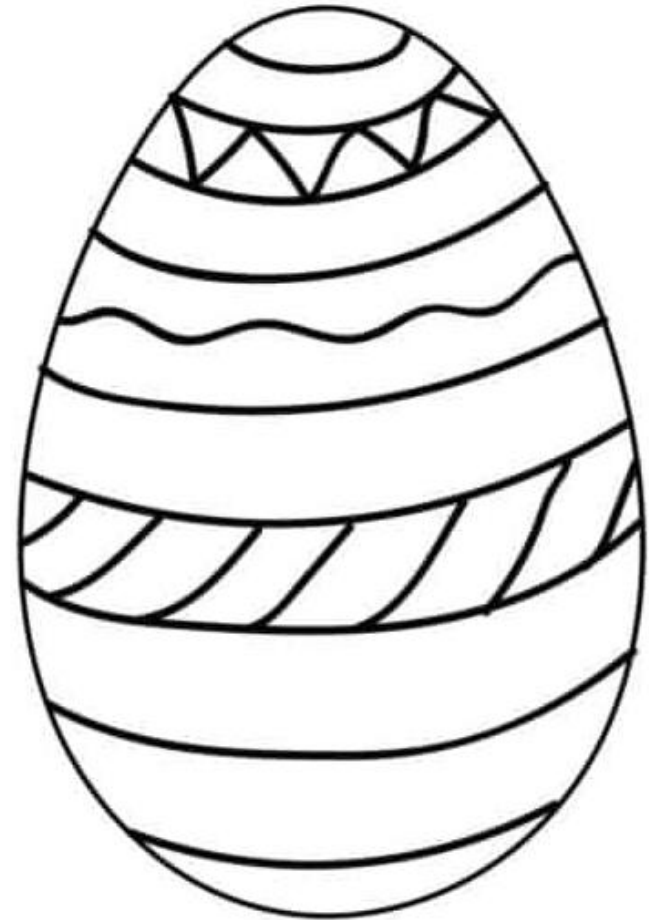
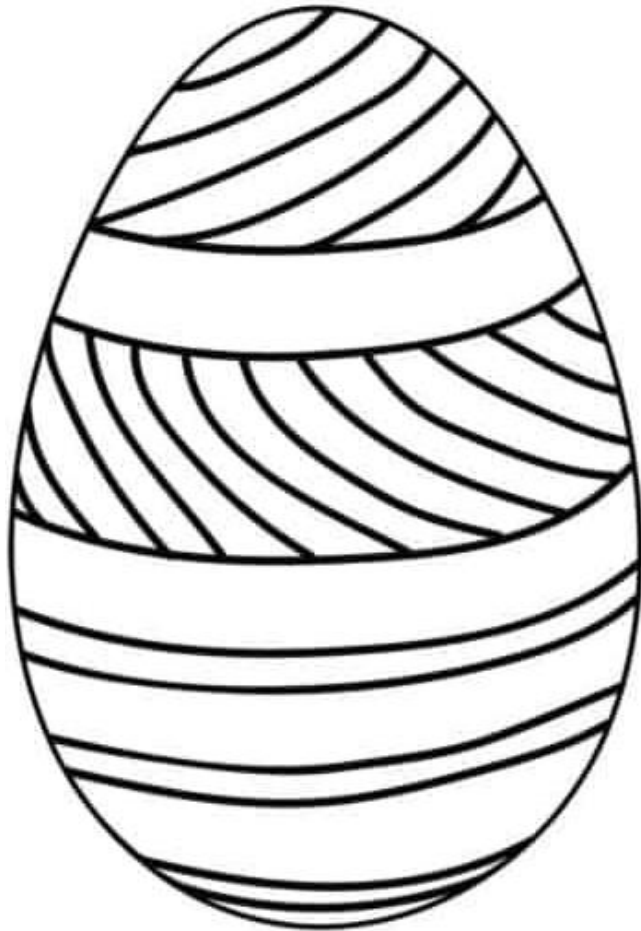
- A table covering!
- A tray
- Sturdy paper or a paper plate
- Pencil
- PVA glue in a bottle
- Liquid watercolour paint
- Paint brush
- Salt

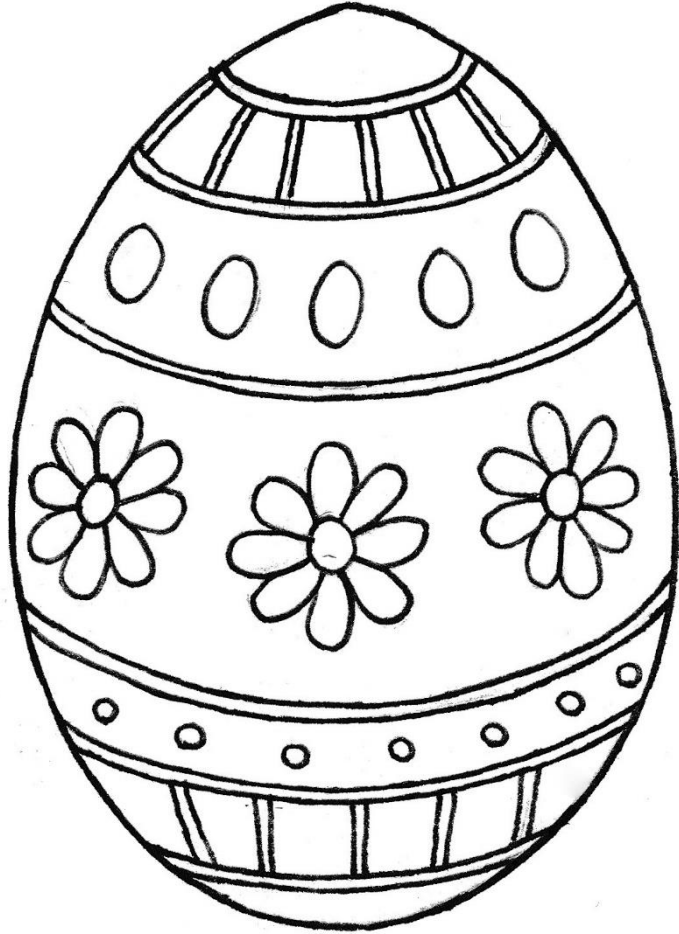
What to do:

1. Use the egg shape opposite as a template or draw/trace the designs on the other pages onto the card or paper plate with a pencil
2. Draw over the pencil lines with the PVA glue
3. Over the tray (or a separate dish) cover the PVA glue with salt – make sure it is all covered then shake off any excess salt.
4. Take the paintbrush and dip it into the paint and just touch the salt glue lightly – watch the colour travel along the salt glue
5. Add as many more colours until you are happy with your picture
6. Set to one side to dry (it may take overnight dependent on how much glue was used)
7. Create another picture
8. Don't forget to take photographs of your creations and post them to Facebook so we can see your work!
